The Ottawa High School basketball programs will be running their annual basketball camps for grades 3 through 12 on June 16-19, 2009. The cost of the camp will be \$25 which includes a camp T-shirt.

The objective of the camps are to ensure that each individual is provided an opportunity to learn and sharpen their fundamental basketball skills. It is our hope that each player can take some part of their camp experience home with them and use it to become a better basketball player.

The camp will include basketball fundamentals, individual and team offense, individual and team defense, and scrimmages. There will also be information available for summer workout drills that include ball handling, shooting, and post player moves.

Fundamentals

Fundamentals are the backbone of every championship program. We will demonstrate and practice fundamentals everyday in camp and provide you with drills and schedules that can be used throughout the off-season.

Camp Sessions

YOUNG PLAYERS CAMP ● 8:30-10:30PM

Basic instruction to the game, its rules and techniques. Boys entering 3rd through 5th grades are eligible for the camp, which will run June 16 - 19, from 8:30am-10:30am. Modification will be made to enhance the learning experience, such as lower goals and smaller courts.

MIDDLE SCHOOL CAMP ● 11:00-1:00PM

Players entering grades 6th through 8th are eligible for this camp. This session will focus on the fundamentals and basic concepts of defense, offense, and team orientation. Special attention will be given to team defense and offensive individual fundamentals such as shooting, reading defenders on screen work, and 1 on 1 play.

The Cyclone Basketball Day Camp is open to any player who loves basketball and would like the opportunity to improve their game.

The camp size will be limited to ensure a small player to coach ratio.
